How can you choose to do God's will when you don't know what it is?

“I want your will in my life, God. Before I fully know what it is!”

“Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will.”

ROMANS 12:2

Experiencing God’s will:

- **Offer your body** = be available to God
- **Good** = good for you, healthy
- **Pleasing** = tastes good, too! *(That doesn’t mean it’s easy.)*
- **Perfect** = complete, all you need is there *(You don’t have to look outside the will of God for what it takes to put the puzzle of your life together.)*
- **Test and approve** = experiment. Check it out by faith.

Do you want to know His will? Are you willing to let Him guide your thinking, to renew your mind? Are you open and available?

Step out and step into what God shows you by faith. Follow the steps He shows you. As you step toward it, it opens and finds you.

Imagine saying ‘yes’ and then discovering God’s best offer gets better every day that you are in it. That’s the Christ journey.
