"Elisha died and was buried. Now Moabite raiders used to enter the country every spring. Once while some Israelites were burying a man, suddenly they saw a band of raiders. So they threw the man's body into Elisha's tomb. When the body touched Elisha's bones, the man came to life and stood up on his feet!"

2 Kings 13:20-21

Elisha had a story God was writing in his life that was different from Elijah's. Your story will be unique, too.

The name Elisha means "God is salvation," and his ministry was from God's immeasurably more double portion of Spirit.



God doesn't want us all doing the same things in the same way.

What's your story? Who is God calling you to be?

"I gotta be me!"

God knows the desire of your heart. He wants to lead you to find its fulfillment in Him.

"We do not dare classify or compare ourselves with some who commend themselves. When they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are not wise."

2 Corinthians 10:12

Live your calling from God and you'll leave a life-giving legacy.

The Book of Revelation tells us when we live out of the story God has for us in Christ, we will find power to even overcome the devil.

"They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony." *Revelation 12:11*

Having a testimony is you living in the story of God's forgiveness and freedom.

God's amazing life-giving grace is flowing through you, your spiritual gifts, your acts of service, and your expression of God's character through your vocation.

"Ask...Seek...Knock and the door will be opened for you." Matthew 7:7

We stand in the middle of God-sized visions now because of people who, though no longer with us in body, planted seeds that are now bearing fruit.

Even though Elisha spent his life helping his neighbors, trying to help his nation and even loving his enemies - evil rulers avoided him and complacent people neglected him.

King Jehoash is still fighting Aram, the Syrians that have oppressed Israel for decades. He came to Elisha to get some help.

"He did evil in the eyes of the Lord and did not turn away from any of the sins of Jeroboam, son of Nebat, which he had caused Israel to commit; he continued in them."



2 Kings 13:11

"My Father! My Father! The chariots and horsemen of Israel!" 2 Kings 13:14

The king could be referring to Elijah being taken up into heaven or helping Elisha see that God's army surrounding them was greater than the enemy's forces.

"The Lord's arrow of victory, the arrow of victory over Aram!" 2 Kings 13:17

"You should have struck the ground five or six times; then you would have defeated Aram and completely destroyed it. But now you will defeat it only three times." 2 Kings 13:19

The man of God has not lost his focus even though he's losing his health.

The King, instead of learning from the past, keeps repeating its mistakes in the present.

The King is asking for too little provision with too little passion.

God's still willing to give victory but meets us at our point of passion.

The state of the nation: half-hearted devotion with a foot in two worlds.

All for God on Sunday, and living for yourself on Monday.

"They are double-minded, unstable in all their ways." James 1:8

The King aimed too low and quit too soon.

How men and nations go down: instead of seeking the double portion that leads to victory, they live the double-standard that brings defeat.

What story are you living?

God's grace is greater than all our sin. His mercy is bigger than all our mistakes. We find it when we come in seeking with all our hearts.
