What do you do when the future is mashing up with your past and that's your present experience? What do you do in the present when your future puts the squeeze on your past? Today's featured film helps look at how not to let the past blow up our present and affect our future.

What do you do when the future is mashing up with your past and that's your present experience?

What do you do in the present when your future puts the squeeze on your past?

At 30, some say, what's going on in my life? I thought I'd have more to show. At 40, is this what I'm going to be? At 50, where has my life gone? Maverick is now 57.

Can I face what the future is lying before me from the past without blowing something up in the present?

Pete Mitchell brings all of his past – his skills, competencies, risk-taking courage and Achilles' heel of defying authority and pride - the essence of his past - to bear on the future in his present.

Will he blow it up? Will he come out alive? Will he learn and grow?

Penny sees no future in the present with Maverick because of his past.

Rooster blames Mav for his father's death and resents him for interfering in his own military career.

The future opens before them because Maverick takes what he has from the past and applies it in the present.

Another mash-up is with Iceman, Maverick's former nemesis and competitive opponent, who is now an Admiral.

How can you ride the wave of your past in the present toward the future without blowing the wrong stuff up?

Maverick's way had always been the way of pride.

Something's happening - themes of fatherhood, brotherhood, loyalty, courage, even vulnerability are emerging.

"Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall."



Proverbs 16:18

That's why stuff blows up in his life, his work, and his relationships.

Maverick can't see a way forward. Iceman writes it out for him: It's time to let go.

It's time to lead by letting go.

Maverick says, I don't know how. The greatest battle of his life is with himself.

Let go. Give it to God. Let go and let God.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not into your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him and he will make your paths straight." *Proverbs 3:5-6*

Release your life, your concerns to Christ and put your hand in His. He knows how to pilot you through life and death. This is the way to freedom, to maturity.
