NOTES

Life can be brutal. Hard to watch. Harder to do and endure.

Boxing is a metaphor we find true in our lives.

"I do not box as one beating the air..." 1 Corinthians 9:27

- "I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave..." 1 Corinthians 9:28
- "I have fought the good fight. I have finished the race." 2 Timothy 4:7

"I've gone the distance. All 15 rounds in the fight of my life."

Do I have what it takes? Do I really belong here? Will where I came from keep me from getting where I'm going?

All through the movie, Rocky fights the idea that he's just a bum.

Characters in both movies are fighting issues from their past and circumstances in their present that could stifle their chances to rise in life.

These movies are not really about boxing but about human drama and the fight of our lives for validation, for acceptance as keys to life.

Each of them has reason to stop fighting. But the solution in each situation is found in going the distance.

If you want to go the distance...

Start with Jesus Christ

In Matthew 13 Jesus tells a story about seeds (the Word of God) and soils (our lives). Some soil is receptive but others are too hard-surfaced, too rocky underneath, too choked by weeds to grow and produce – just like the characters.

How do you go the distance? Get your soil responsive to the seed of God's promise?

- Ask the deep questions
- Face the hard reality
- Find the right coach
- Don't stop 'til you hear the bell
- Turn to God in a seeking faith



Start with Jesus Christ
